This contest is organized by the Culture and Development Public Benefit Corporation of the Municipality of Pella (DIKEPAP) in the framework of the project "Energy Efficiency in the cross border area as an indicative factor for environmental policy project" with the acronym ENPOL- EE. The project is co-financed by the European Union and by national funds of the participating countries.

The participants of the contest can be students from the High Schools of the Municipality of Pella (Greece) and the Municipality of Negotino (Republic of North Macedonia).

The contest theme is the energy efficiency improvement and its immediate positive impact on the environment. "Energy efficiency" refers to energy consuming activities, mainly related to buildings and their outdoor spaces, as well as to equipment of all kinds (eg cars, domestic equipment, etc.).

The aim of the competition is for the students to understand and then creatively capture the positive impact of implementing energy efficiency tactics in their daily lives and how to use them in order to protect the environment and reduce carbon dioxide.

Students are asked to think of (a) ways to improve the energy efficiency of their homes and (b) ways to save energy in their homes, and then use these ideas to take pictures.

Students can photograph spontaneous or directed scenes that convey the message of energy efficiency.

Either black and white or color photography is accepted.

Digital photo processing is not recommended.

Students can work in groups or individually.

Award

A total of 3 awards will be given to the top three projects. These awards will be audiovisual equipment that will be installed in the winners' classrooms. Additionally, there will be 3 runners-up. In the case of mainly awarded students belong to the same class; one prize will be given to the first runner-up. All students of the winning teams (winners and runners-up) will receive an honorary diploma.

The award ceremony will take place at a special event.

Instructions for the Schools of the Municipality of Pella

The photograph is printed in 25X25cm size on photographic paper. It has to be marked at the back side by an 8-digit number and to be sealed in an envelope. The 8-digit number has to be outlined on the envelope. The envelope must contain an A4 sheet stating the name of the art project, the students' names, the class they belong to and the name of the school.

For the participation, candidates must submit to DIKEPAP:

- (a) the original photograph
- (b) the closed envelope.

Instructions for the Schools of the Municipality of Negotino

The photograph must be printed on a 25x25 cm photo paper, marked by an 8-digit number on the backside sealed in an envelope. The 8-digit number has to be outlined on the envelope. The envelope must contain an A4 sheet stating (in English) the name of the art project, the students' names, the class they belong to and the name of the school.

For the participation, candidates must submit to the Municipality of Negotino:

(a) the original photograph

(b) the closed envelope.

Then, the Municipality of Negotino must transfer all the participations to the headquarters of DIKEPAP. If this transfer is not possible, all submitted photos will be sent to DIKEPAP via web. In every photo title, the unique 8-digit code of the project must be included (eg 11112222a, 11112222b, 11112222c).
